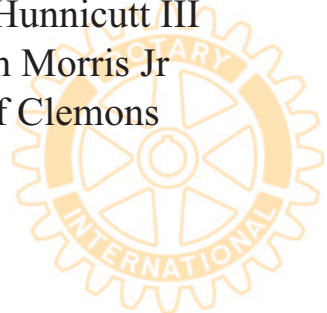

# A ROTARY YEAR OF ACCOMPLISHMENT

## A ROTARY YEAR OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

During the past Rotary Year, our club met the challenge of President D.K. Lee's and District Bill Pollard's theme "Make Dreams Real." Our club continues to serve our community and fellow man by the wonderful projects and activities accomplished this year. These include:

- o A grant to help the Lackey Free Clinic in the amount of \$5,600. Our club contributed \$3,000 and received a District Simplified Grant of \$2,600.
- o Continuing to award a CNU Endowed Scholarship. This year's recipient, Tiffany Cook, received \$3,600.
- o A gift to Star Achievers Academy from the Tennis Ball proceeds in the amount of \$14,000.
- o A contribution to the Building Bridges program in the amount of \$500.
- o Sponsorship of the RSVP Luncheon of \$600 and club member participation.
- o Supporting the second annual Richard Summerville Leadership Seminar at CNU in the amount of \$300.
- o Sponsoring a PCHS Interact club member to attend RYLA in the amount of \$250.
- o Making a donation to the Polio Challenge (Bill/Melinda Gates Foundation) in the amount of \$1,000.
- o Completing the sewage treatment plant at the Carmen Lyra School in partnership with the Escazu, Costa Rica Rotary Club and a grant from RI. Total cost of the project was approximately \$35,000 with a club contribution of \$10,100
- o Presenting the Martin Gracey Award to John Johnson, and a check for \$1,000 to H.E.L.P., Mr. Johnson's organization.



Other activities included:

- o The annual Salvation Army Bell Ringing in December
- o Tennis Ball participation - volunteers, sponsors and attendees.



- o Hosting a Rotary Youth Exchange student, Marlene Till, from Germany. Two club families – The Jones' and the Strehles' – were host families for Marlene.
- o Mentoring a successful Interact Club at PCHS. This Interact Club raised \$1,000 for the Costa Rica Project again this year.
- o Cosponsoring with the Warwick Club – the Rotoract Club at CNU.
- o Sending 12 delegates to the District Conference in October.
- o Sending 9 delegates to the District Assembly in April.
- o Continuing to work on the Boundless Playground in Deer Park

In addition, club members are serving in District 7600 leadership capacities:

- o Diane Hagemann is serving her second term as District Secretary
- o Ray Spencer and Diane Hagemann are serving again on the GSE (Group Study Exchange) Peninsula committee.
- o Susan Strehle is serving as Inbound Chair for Rotary Youth Exchange
- o Cap Neilson is serving as District Communications Chair
- o Danny Carroll is serving as District Awards Chair
- o Jim Pierce was the Immediate Past District Governor, served as President D.K. Lee's personal representative at Mr. Lee's District Conference in South Korea and will serve as Zone Foundation Chair.

Our club also became 100% Paul Harris Fellows this spring and has met yet again ALL of its other Foundation goals.
