THE 4-WAY TEST

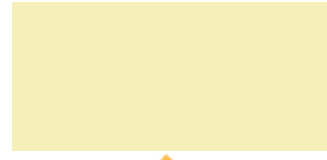

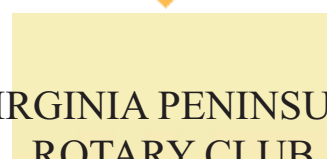

2009-2010 Installation of Officers BBQ Fun Family Event at Colonial Downs

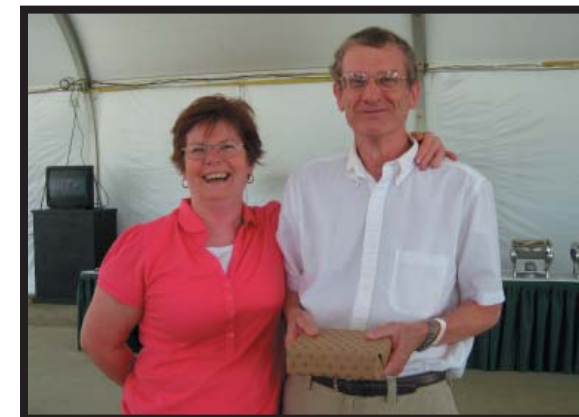
