

The project aimed at improving the quality of two early childhood education centers in the Hampton Roads area; Stepping Stones in Newport News and Smiles and Giggles in Hampton. Volunteers painted walls, cleaned windows, painted cubbies and bookshelves, repaired a fence, and organized a nursery. By providing funding for learning materials and completing hands-on projects for facility improvements, we were able to make a significant difference at these centers. 
