### Peninsula Catholic Interact



Peninsula Catholic High School Interact officers for 2008-09 were recently installed at a club meeting by President Gail. Lauren Igel is president; Kayla Owata, vice-president; Julia Vaughn, secretary; Angela Delucia, treasurer; and Hannah Ellis, historian. Linda Ellis continues her excellent service as faculty sponsor. The Interact Club has demonstrated its commitment to “service above self” in many ways, including raising more than \$3,000 for improvements to sanitation facilities at the Carmen Lyra School in Costa Rica, enthusiastically participating in Salvation Army Bell Ringing at the local malls and in our Career Day, serving meals at our RSVP luncheon. Rotary's first Interact club was chartered in 1962 in Melbourne, Florida. Today, there are 8,600 Interact clubs in 110 countries with nearly 200,000 members. Charlie Firestone, District 7600 Interact coordinator, reported that there are 46 clubs in our district. Efforts to create an Interact club at Peninsula Catholic High School was initiated by our club in December 2005 and the official Chartering Ceremony occurred in early 2006.

### President Gail's Goals for 2008-09

At the Club Assembly, President Gail outlined several goals she has set for her leadership year. One is to increase membership. This is an ongoing goal if we, as a club, are to remain vital and develop new leadership for the future. Second, she proposes creating Rotary mentorships. Third is to respond to International President D.K. Lee's plea for each Rotary club to pledge a minimum of \$3,000 over the next three years to meet the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation's challenge grant to eliminate polio. Our club has already responded to this plea and Treasurer Scott Stollendorf has already mailed our first installation.

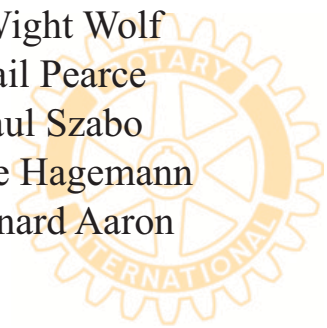

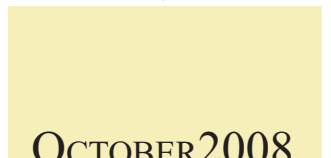
